Bowentown Boating and Sport Fishing Club - CCTV Policy

1. Purpose

The purpose of this CCTV Policy is to outline the guidelines and procedures for the use of Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) systems within the premises of the Bowentown Boating and Sport Fishing Club. The primary objectives are to enhance the security and safety of individuals, protect club property, and deter criminal activities.
