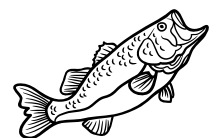

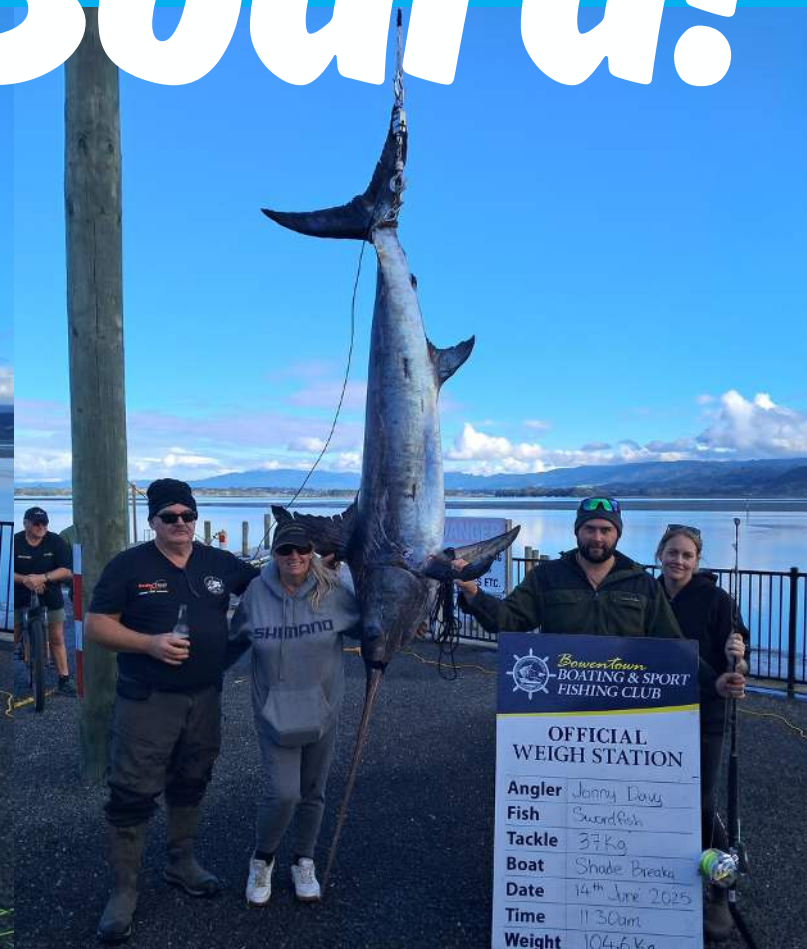
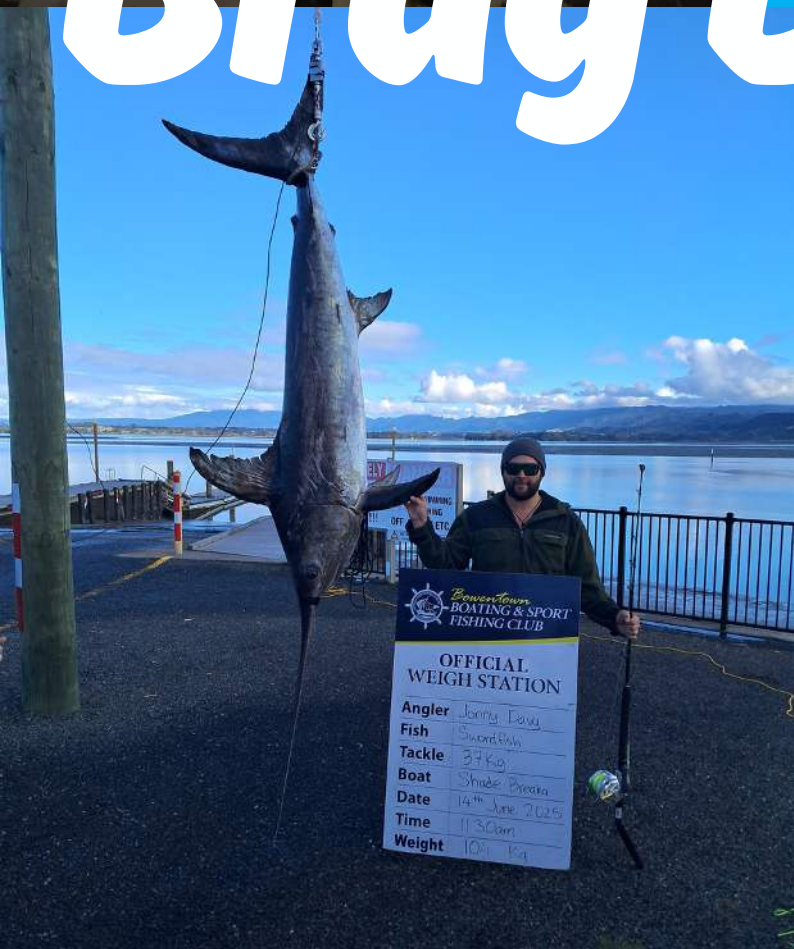

Mussels with basil and lemon grass

On the table in
20 minutes



- 1kg Mussels
- 1 tablespoon peanut oil
- 2 cloves garlic, crushed
- 1 medium brown onion, chopped finely
- 10cm stick (20g) fresh lemon grass, chopped finely
- 1 fresh small red Thai chilli, chopped finely
- 1c dry white wine
- 2 tablespoons lime juice
- 2 tablespoons fish sauce
- ½ loosely packed Thai basil leaves
- ½ coconut milk
- Spring onions and Thai chilli for garnish

Scrub mussels, remove beards.
Heat oil in a wok or large frying pan; stir-fry onion, garlic, lemon grass and chopped chilli until softened.
Add wine, juice and sauce into wok, bring to the boil. Add Mussels; reduce heat and simmer, covered for about 5 minutes or until mussels are open(discard ones that do not open).
Meanwhile, shred basil finely. Add shredded basil and coconut milk to wok, heat through. Place mussel mixture in serving bowl, pour over the sauce and top with spring onions and chilli for garnish
